



## Directions...

Direction to O Communications, Stepney Bank  
(Inside Woods Pottery - first floor)

The City of Newcastle is reached by the A1(M) from London in the south and Edinburgh in the north.

It can also be accessed from the south-west and west to Carlisle via the M6, and the A19 from York.

### WHEN TRAVELLING FROM THE A1(M) SOUTH

When you have passed the Washington Services, Chester-le-street, bear left on the A1 (signposted A1, Newcastle, Gateshead). Continue forward then at junction 65, take the slip road signed A184 ( Gateshead, Newcastle Centre). Continue forward onto the A6082 and bear right onto the Redheugh Bridge. Follow the directions from the Redheugh Bridge.

### WHEN TRAVELLING FROM THE A1(M) NORTH

After passing Metrocentre take the 2nd slip road off the A1 which is signposted A184, Gateshead/Newcastle. Stay in the right-hand lane and after a mile; you will head over the Redheugh Bridge. Now follow the directions from the Redheugh Bridge.

### FROM THE REDHEUGH BRIDGE

If arriving via the Redheugh Bridge (A184), continue onto St James' Boulevard and at the second major set of traffic lights turn right onto Westgate Road. Travel straight down the road, through several sets of traffic lights until you come to a large roundabout (you will see 55° North in front of you). Take the second exit off the roundabout signposted the A167 motorway. Do not join the motorway but continue parallel up to the Newbridge Street roundabout. Take the 4th exit onto the A193 (signposted Wallsend, Heaton, Byker, A188, A193). Continue through two sets of traffic lights. At the third set of lights turn right onto Crawhall Road (the Tanners pub will be on the corner). Take your first left onto Stepney Bank and

continue down until you come to a building called Woods Pottery on the right hand side (just past the big white building called Northern Printworks). Pull into the courtyard at the back and the entrance is at the door near the picnic tables. If you go down the hill as far as the Cluny pub you have gone too far.

### TYNE BRIDGE/CITY CENTRE

From the A184 continue straight ahead (you will pass Gateshead stadium on opposite side of the road). When you reach the roundabout take the 3rd exit and merge onto the A167 (signposted Newcastle). Continue forward over the Tyne Bridge. Continue forward onto the A167 and take the 2nd exit onto the Newbridge Street Roundabout. Take the 4th exit onto the A193 (signposted Wallsend, Heaton, Byker, A188, A193). Continue through two sets of traffic lights. At the third set of lights turn right onto Crawhall Road (the Tanners pub will be on the corner). Take your first left onto Stepney Bank and continue down until you come to a building called Woods Pottery on the right hand side (just past the big white building called Northern Printworks). Pull into the courtyard at the back and the entrance is at the door near the picnic tables. If you go down the hill as far as the Cluny pub you have gone too far.

### PARKING

There is a courtyard to the rear of the building where there is a free car park that is available for visitors to use.
